world animal day (oct 4)

Ocean Lotions

We've come a long way from our whaling days on Long Island! Discover how to create animal-friendly sugar and salt scrubs, soaks, and balms (no animal testing), and go home with your own bathtime mixtures. Gr 2-6 or Tweens/Teens.

national pretzel month (oct)

Pretzel-Making Workshop

Did you know October is Pretzel Month? Learn about the history of pretzels and find out how yeast and molds, including ocean molds, work. Mix up a batch of pretzel dough and shape it into an ocean animal to bake at home! Gr 2-6 and Tweens/Teens who love to bake!

halloween

Bones, Bones, Bones

Be a Bone Detective and examine all sorts of animal bones for clues. Touch whale bones, other animal bones, mystery teeth, even some fossil bones! Dissect an Owl Pellet and identify bones from an owl's lunch. Gr 1-6.

Disgusting Things from the Deep

Come explore the spooky, slimy, and downright gross side of the aquatic world. Get ready to touch the icky and the sticky, and learn about animals like the blobfish! Create a batch of your own gooey slime to take home. Gr 1-6.

thanksgiving

Thanksgiving Feast on a Whaleship

Find out about the "feast" you and your crew would have if you lived on a 19th-century whaling ship. Make your own hard tack and a fizzy lemon drink (to prevent scurvy!). Touch a real ditty bag and some of the tools a whaler always had close at hand and make your own hand-woven basket to take home! Gr. 5+ (Younger kids can decorate their own travel cup to bring to Thanksgiving dinner! Gr. 2-4

Native American Crafts

Learn about the first Long Island communities and find out about Native tribes. Touch a Native American oil lamp, see real arrowheads, and create a wampum necklace with a stone arrowhead. Gr 2-6. 45 min.

national cookie day (dec 4)

Sea Cookie Workshop

Let's Eat! In honor of National Cookie Day, explore unusual ways sea creatures get their nourishment in the ocean. Decorate your own colorful seascape on your cookie with frosting and sprinkles. Delicious! Ages 3-5 or Gr 1-6. *Let us know about known dietary allergies / kosher requirements.*



Have fun learning about glass! Touch old bottles from our collection and find out if glass is a liquid or a solid in hands-on experiments (you'd be surprised). Create your own sea-glass mosaic holiday ornament or decoration. Gr 1-6.

Whaling was one of the earliest integrated professions in America. Celebrate Martin Luther King Day (Jan 19) by learning about well-remembered African American captains, touch some of the navigational tools they used, and create your own "I Have a Dream" dream catcher to take home! Gr 2-6.

Ice is Nice

As the weather turns cold, explore the science of ice! Try your hand at icy science experiments. Create your own icy masterpiece by painting with colored ice, and learn how to make ice cream using melted ice! Gr 1-6.

Whales in the Winter / Arctic Snowglobes


