# Summer programs

P = preschool T = tweens & teens

Activities in a given program are adapted to specialized age groups. They're all fun!

## NOCTURNAL LIFE

### MIDNIGHT APPETITE P E

Learn about sharks and their extreme appetite at night. See and touch shark teeth, including a tooth from a prehistoric Megalodon shark! Touch and identify shark teeth up close and make a shark necklace or keychain.

### WHALE PILLOW WORKSHOP P E T

Did you know whales sleep with half their brains at a time? Learn amazing facts about the world's largest creatures! Touch giant whale bones, teeth, and artifacts, and create a fluffy whale pillow with sewing and decorating.

### SENSES IN THE SHADOWS P E

Close your eyes and get ready to try your other senses of touch, smell, sound, and taste with hands-on experiment stations. Find out ways nocturnal animals use their senses and play senses games to test your own sense-abilities with sound matching, lollipop tasting, and quirky smelling. Take your sense-ational crafts home.

### NOCTURNAL NOSES P E

Use your nose like a nocturnal animal and try smell-matching, identifying scents, and other smell games. Find out how people used ambergris from whales to create perfume, and choose your own scents for your fragrance batch to go home with your own perfume.

### BONES AFTER BEDTIME E T

Are you ready to dissect an owl pellet? Enter the world of bones – touch the giant bones of whales and some other nocturnal animals, including an opossum skull. Then, take apart an owl pellet and study the bones up close! Take your findings home.

### TEETH IN THE TWILIGHT P E

In honor of the Tooth Fairy's visits in the night, learn about amazing teeth in the natural world. Explore and touch enormous whale teeth, prickly shark teeth, a mosasaur tooth, and gnawing rodent teeth. Decorate a tooth fairy box.



### CRICKETFEST P

Join us in celebrating one of nighttime's singing animals - crickets. Read "The Little Cricket," and meet tiny crickets up close! Learn about their body parts, try your own sound experiments to learn how crickets make sound, and design your own cricket costume!

### SEA TURTLES AT SUNDOWN E

Discover how turtles emerge from the sea at night to lay their eggs in the sand. Touch a turtle shell and artifacts from tortoiseshell, find out how hatchlings use the moon for direction, and try your own luck as a turtle in our Turtle Exploration Game. *Reading required.*

### SOUNDS OF THE NIGHT P E

Explore how whales and nocturnal animals use the amazing world of sound to get around in the dark. Touch a whale earbone and test your own ears by trying hands-on sound experiment stations with tuning forks, vibrating shakers, and other instruments. Create your own musical instrument.

## ART AT NIGHT

### DARK & DELICIOUS T

Learn how to create a Chocolate Painting using melted dark chocolate. Use our artifacts for inspiration to sketch, draw, and paint a monochromatic object, scene, or sea-scape, and take home your edible and delicious masterpiece. *Micro-wave required.*

### STARRY STARRY NIGHT T

Explore ways artists have captured the night. We will focus on dark seascapes to learn effects of portraying light and dark to bring out your own inner artist. Grab charcoal and watercolor to create a nightscape. All art materials supplied. For beginners or intermediate. *Limited dates available.*

### SLEEPY SALVES T

Mix up soothing masks with sea salts and other creations out of natural ingredients to become part of your nightly routine. Use lavender scents to help you feel sleepy, fill a tea bag with chamomile, and go home with your creations. Bon Nuit!



## SPOOKS & MAGIC

### I SEA A SEA MONSTER E

Learn about how legends like the Loch Ness, Kraken, Sea Serpents, Mermaids and other mystical sea creatures originate, and create your own Sea Monster from your imagination with clay and Monster Goo!

### WANDS, WIZARDS, & WAVES E

Calling all witches and wizards! Learn about sailors' superstitions and magical beliefs while at sea. Visit our fizzy, sticky Potions Tables to see what's bubbling and choose your secret ingredients to create your own wand.



## STARS & SPACE

### SAILORS AND STARS E

Explore how sailors use the stars to navigate their way during the darkest hours at sea. Touch nautical tools, learn how to use star constellations in our exploration game, and create your own star constellation viewer.

### TIDES & TREATS E

What makes tides come up high and low? Find out about the phases of the moon and how it affects our ocean. Design moon phases and star constellations on cookies using icing, sprinkles, and other candy treats! Yum!

### BLASTOFF TO THE STARS E

Discover the different ways people have gotten around through the years – from wooden sailships to flying rocketships. Touch ship tools, learn how rockets take off, and create your own flying rocket!

## DREAMS

### NATIVE AMERICAN DREAMS P E T

Learn about Native American life and culture, both on Long Island and America. Touch Native American artifacts like a stone oil lamp and arrowheads, listen to Native legends and create a hanging Dreamcatcher with glow-in-the-dark beads to hang above your bed. Happy Dreams!

## DARK ADVENTURES

### THE DARKEST PLACE ON EARTH E

Visit the deepest, darkest place on earth – the bottom of the sea. Find out about its unusual creatures, learn about bioluminescence, and play a glowing game. Create and decorate your own night-light to brighten your room at night!

### LIGHTHOUSES AFTER DARK E

Learn about lighthouses around the world, see how their lens work, and grab a compass to become a traveling explorer in our game where lighthouses direct your journey. Try out a job of a lighthouse keeper and create your own lighthouse that really flickers! *Reading required.*

### LIGHT UP THE NIGHT! E T

Explore what lights up at night, from a Native American stone lamp to metal whale oil lamps. Touch a whale candle and roll your own beeswax candle and candleholder to light at home. *2<sup>nd</sup> gr up.*



### DARK SUBMARINES E

Enter the deep world of submarines. Find out how these underwater ships work, how they dive and rise to the surface, and how their design has changed over history. Create your own periscope so you can peek around corners on your journeys.

### IT'S ELECTRIC! P E

Explore how electricity lights up the dark night. Did you know your brain uses electricity, too? See what glows, moves, or buzzes in our hands-on electric and static experiments. Design your own glow-in-the-dark animal!

### DOLPHIN SHADOWS P E

Learn all about the smallest whale - the dolphin! Discover how dolphins move, eat, and grow, touch a dolphin bone, and create a paper dolphin shadow puppet. Step in front of a blue light to watch your dolphin's shadow swim! *Screen or white wall required.*
